

Chef Job Description

Chef Job Duties:

- leads kitchen team in chef's absence
- oversees and organises kitchen stock and ingredients

- assist with ordering by ensuring best prices from the supplier, waste reduction and manage budgetary concerns
- ensure all food is prepared and presented to a consistent standard every time.
- work with head chef to maintain kitchen organisation, staff ability, and training opportunities
- check all catering equipment is working and to report problems efficiently.
- assists head chef with menu creation
- assists the restaurant management team with staff rotas, staff training and to ensure the smooth running of the kitchen.
